ORDER:

In the G.O.1st read above, based on the proposals of the Education Department, the Finance Department issued orders according sanction for the upgradation of 1500 Language Pandit posts as School Assistants (Languages) and another 500 Physical Education Teacher (PET) posts as School Assistants (Physical Education) in the Success Schools in the State by suppressing 102 Secondary Grade Teacher (SGT) posts.

In the references 2nd read above, the Director of School Education, TS., Hyderabad has submitted the proposals for upgradation of 2487 Language Pandit posts to that of School Assistants (Languages) and another 1047 Physical Education Teacher (PET) posts as School Assistants (Physical Education) in the State, based on the latest enrolment as on 30.06.2016 and as per the rationalization norms issued in G.O.Ms.No.11, School Education (Services-II) Department, dt.15.06.2015, by taking into account minimum enrolment of 220 Students in the High Schools. He has also submitted the financial commitment for the upgradation of 2487 Language Pandit posts as School Assistants (Languages) as Rs.8.44 Crores and for the upgradation of 1047 PET posts as School Assistants (Physical Education) as Rs.3.55 Crores i.e., total Rs.11.99 Crores. He has also worked out the surplus vacant SGT posts required to be suppressed and proposed that 392 SGT surplus vacant posts can be suppressed in order to upgrade 2487 Language Pandit posts to that of School Assistants (Languages) and another 1047 Physical Education Teachers (PET) posts as School Assistants (Physical Education) in the State.

- <u>3.</u> In the reference 4th read above, the School Education Department informed that based on the CMP received in the matter vide reference 3rd above, the request for filling up the School Assistants (Languages) posts as mentioned above by the existing Language Pandits by absorbing them as School Assistants (Languages) as per their seniority was examined and accordingly the Department proposes to absorb the existing Language Pandits as School Assistants (Languages) based on their seniority and eligibility as per rules in the posts upgraded as School Assistants (Languages) proposed by the Director of School Education, TS., Hyderabad in the references 2nd read above.
- <u>4.</u> After careful examination of the proposal, Government hereby accord sanction for the upgradation of 2487 Language Pandits as School Assistants (Languages) and also upgradation of 1047 Physical Education Teacher (PET) posts as School Assistants (Physical Education) in the State by suppressing 392 surplus vacant posts Secondary Grade Teacher (SGT).
- **<u>5.</u>** The School Education Department shall take further necessary action accordingly.
